Help Us Keep Everyone Healthy

As we move through the colder months, we kindly ask that any patients experiencing flu-like symptoms (such as cough, sore throat, fever, or congestion) to wear a face mask when visiting the practice. This small step helps protect our more vulnerable patients and our staff, reducing the spread of seasonal illnesses.

Masks are available at reception if you need one — thank you for helping us keep our community safe and well.

Submitting an "urgent" request

askmyGP opening times have changed in line with the Government's guidelines so it is now open from 08:00 to 18:30 Monday to Friday for routine requests, nurse and blood appointments and admin enquiries.

For **urgent requests** patients can use askmyGP from 08:00 to 16:00 Monday to Friday.

Between 16:00 to 18:30 Monday to Friday, patients must telephone the surgery if the request is **urgent**. This is imperative because the "routine" inbox is not monitored frequently enough to answer urgent requests.

If a patient submits an "urgent" askmyGP request using the "routine" option online and after 16:00,

there is considerable risk that it will not be reviewed until the following day or two.

After 18:30 Monday to Friday, the surgery is closed and patients should use the 111 service until the surgery reopens the next working day at 08:00.

Vaccination clinics

Thank you to all the staff who worked on Saturdays to administer and carry out duties at our vaccination clinics in October.

This year, some patients were left confused and frustrated by the Government's changes to the criteria surrounding eligibility for the covid vaccination. This was unfortunately beyond the control of 168 Medical Group who have to comply with the decisions made by the Department of Health.

It is hoped that next year these decisions will be made by the Government earlier and that there will be more clarity for patients prior to their vaccination appointments, thus avoiding disappointment and anxiety on the day.
